1 SPACE EXPLORATION

***SCIENCE / ELA**

Scholars launch into a STEM-powered mission through our solar system as they explore galaxies, black holes, and the future of moon colonization. They plan and simulate a lunar mission, engineer a moon rover, and build and launch a rocket as NASA prepares the next generation of space explorers to set foot on the Moon again after more than 50 years.



2 HEALTH PROFESSIONS

***SCIENCE / ELA**

Scholars step into the fast-paced world of healthcare as they explore careers in medicine, nursing, and physical therapy. Through realistic simulations and hands-on clinical activities, they develop problem-solving skills, empathy, and leadership while gaining insight into the journey to medical school acceptance and the future of healthcare careers.



3 ARCHITECTURE, ENGINEERING, AND CONSTRUCTION

***MATH / ELA**

Scholars explore the world of architecture, construction, and civil engineering through dynamic design challenges. From building model bridges to creating sustainable 3D floor plans, scholars gain real-world insight into structural design challenges, the real estate industry, and the future of architecture.



4 ENVIRONMENTAL AND ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING

***SCIENCE/MATH**

Scholars become environmental innovators as they explore renewable energy, global climate change, and sustainable initiatives. They tackle challenges like air pollution, ocean plastic, and habitat loss, then engineer eco-friendly inventions. Scholars also participate in an exciting wind turbine competition that generates electricity.

5 CSI FORENSIC SCIENCE

*SCIENCE / ELA

Scholars solve a mysterious murder case as CSI investigators, analyzing evidence using blood splatter, fingerprints, hair analysis, and footprint lab methods. Along the way, they explore careers in law enforcement, forensics, and the U.S. Judicial System, culminating in a mock trial where they present evidence and defend their client in court, one of the suspects in this unsolved murder mystery.

6 BUSINESS AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

*MATH / ELA

Scholars engage in an exciting entrepreneurship and marketing competition. They are challenged to unleash their inner entrepreneur by inventing a product, building a brand, and pitching it to "investors" in a high-energy business challenge. Along the way, they develop critical skills in marketing, finance, creativity, and public speaking, preparing them to thrive in today's global economy.

7 MARINE BIOLOGY

*SCIENCE / ELA

Scholars dive into the fascinating world of marine ecosystems as they explore ocean biodiversity, endangered species, and environmental threats like plastic pollution, rising sea temperatures, and overfishing. Through hands-on discovery and creative problem-solving, they develop innovative solutions to protect marine life and preserve the future of our planet's oceans.

8 DINOSAUR WORLD

*SCIENCE / ELA

Scholars travel back in time to explore Earth's prehistoric geological eras and the fascinating world of dinosaur species that once ruled it. They uncover fossil formations developed millions of years ago, examine Earth's shifting crust, and engage in hands-on activities that bring dinosaurs and their extinction to life in this exciting paleontology experience.

9 DRONES & ROVERS

*SCIENCE / ELA

Scholars learn how drones, robots, and rovers are revolutionizing many industries, from military operations and security surveillance to manufacturing and agriculture. They build and test real prototypes, explore cutting-edge AI tools like ChatGPT, and engineer smart tech solutions that solve real-world problems. This CAMP blends creativity, technology, and engineering in action.

10 EARTH SCIENCE

*SCIENCE / ELA

Scholars explore how our planet's systems work and how human activity impacts the planet. *SCIENCE / ELA

Scholars explore the new world of Generative Artificial Intelligence (AI), how tools like ChatGPT, Claude, and Gemini are transforming how we live, learn, and work. They learn how these AI models are designed and how they are incorporated across different industries to develop AI solutions. Scholars use their creativity, critical thinking, and technology skills to tackle real-world challenges, empowering them to become the next generation of AI developers.

12 MEDIA ARTS AND COMMUNICATION

*SOCIAL STUDIES / ELA

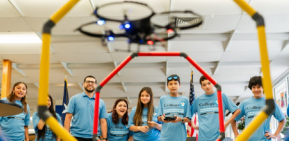
